

































The Future Is Now Gala Experience

On **October 5, 2024**, we ask you to look to the **FUTURE** of Southlake and join us as we gather to celebrate and support making that future a reality **NOW**.

In 2022, the government awarded Southlake a \$5 million planning grant toward **building a NEW Southlake**—the first significant expansion in over two decades. With this investment, we are on our way to becoming a two-site healthcare system with a new state-of-the-art campus and redevelopment of our current site. While this brings hope to our communities, who have been at the forefront of hallway healthcare for too long, it will be at least 10 years before our patients and their families will walk through the doors of a new hospital.

Right now, Southlake faces the most significant challenges in our history. Our communities' accelerated growth and aging population are creating an exponential demand for care that outpaces our capacity. These challenges are felt most acutely in Southlake's Emergency Medicine Program.

The Emergency Department is Southlake's front door. It is the first place people go when in crisis. Open 24 hours a day, seven days a week, Southlake **sees more than 115,000 patients annually**—in **a space built to accommodate 70,000 patients. This means a new patient arrives every 4.5 minutes.** Our Emergency Department's annual visits have doubled over the last 20 years with no expansion. We must enhance our capacity through new space, equipment, and technology. The time is **NOW**.

Southlake is designated as one of Ontario's first Level III Trauma Centres, supporting an interconnected

network of emergency trauma care sites. Our physicians, nurses, and staff work tirelessly to maximize our smaller space, minimize wait times, and maintain the high-quality care we are known for. **Southlake is home to phenomenal talent, but their hard work and uniquely compassionate care only get us so far. They urgently need an environment to match their abilities and efforts**.

Southlake and the communities we serve will only face worsening strain over the coming years if we do not act immediately. **We do not want a lack of space and aging equipment to affect patient care**.

Our community needs the **FUTURE** of healthcare **NOW**. You can be pivotal in building capacity at Southlake's front door, empowering our frontline healthcare heroes to deliver quality and timely emergency care.
